




Writing Prompts:

- Write a story about going to camp with your best friend
- Write a spooky story you could tell while sitting around a campfire

Drawing Prompts:

- Draw your favorite animal from the story
- Draw your favorite camp activity
- Draw or paint a self portrait, just like Louella does in the boo
- Make a birthday card for someone who has a birthday comir up soon!



Story Discussion Questions/Topics:

- What important event did Louella miss because she wasn't listening to Tarantula throughout the story?
- (Follow up) How did Louella feel when she realized she had missed Tarantula's birthday party?
- Talk about a time when you listened to a friend who was telling you something important.

(Listening/Following Directions Activity) Draw By Listening


- Choose a roar scout partner
- One person will draw, the other will give step by step instructions
 - o Draw a square
 - o Draw a circle in the middle of the square
 - o Draw triangle on top of the square
 - o Now draw a bird on top and you have a bird house!
 - o Extra step! Draw a triangle on the bird's head to make a party hat! Did you notice all the party hats in Listen Up, Louella? Check them out!
 - o Time to switch! The roar scout who gave instructions will now have a turn to draw
- Next set of instructions
 - o Draw a rectangle
 - o Draw a smaller rectangle on top of the first rectangle
 - o Draw an even smaller rectangle on top of the second rectangle
 - o Now draw some candles and you have a birthday cake!
 - o Extra step! Draw some small lines on the rectangles to add sprinkles to your cake! Did you notice the birthday cake in Listen Up, Louella? It looked scrumptious!
- Once each Roar Scout has completed the activity, they have earned their Roar Scout Art Badges! Color and cut out the badges.

(Listening Activity) Secret Roar Scout Message

- Divide students into two teams
- Each team stands in a line
- Choose one student from each team and whisper the following sentence to them: "Most of all, Louella loved playing with her fellow campers."
- Those students then whisper the sentence to the first student in their line, and so on, until the last student in line hears the sentence.
- That student then says the sentence aloud. If that sentence is "Most of all, Louella loved playing her fellow campers," the students have earned a Roar Scout Listening badge!

Once each Roar Scout has completed the activity, they have earned their Roar Scout Listening Badges! Color and cut out the badges. *Printable badges on next page*






Activities: Earn Roar Scout Badges!


Roar Scout Scavenger Hunt (home)- Look around and find the following items:


- Pair of shoes


